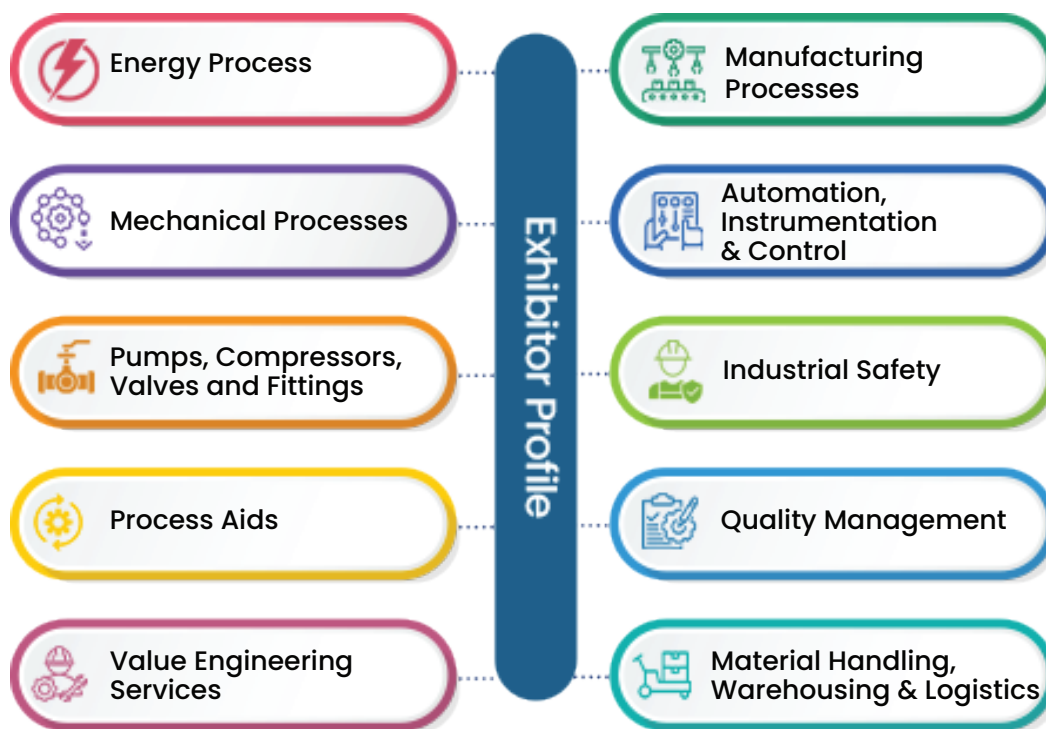
Conference :
